2009 Stallion Service Auction

Rules Of Auction

1. All stallion breedings in the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association Stallion Service Auction have been donated by the stallion owners or designated agents. All breedings will be sold to the highest bidder at the time of the auction. Bidding will open at one half (1/2) of the posted stud fee and bidding will be increased in \$50.00 increments. All stud fees will be sold for a minimum of \$300.00. All stud fees listed at Private Treaty will begin at \$300.00 minimum bid. There will be a \$50.00 Office fee for all breedings sold.
2. Buyers should contact stallion owner/agent PRIOR to purchasing breeding for any other fees associated with breeding their mare. Chute fees, shipping fees, booking fees, mare care fees, freight charges, may apply. PLEASE CONTACT STALLION OWNER FOR ALL ADDITIONAL CHARGES. NORTHEAST TEXAS HORSEMEN'S ASSOCIATION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY OMISSION OF FEES LISTED IN THE STALLION SERVICE AUCTION PROGRAM ASSOCIATED WITH THE BREEDING OF MARES.
3. Purchased breedings are payable the day of the auction. Payments may be made by cash or check. Once breeding is paid in full, stallion owner/agent will be notified and be given all contact information for buyer. All breeding arrangements must be made with the stallion owner/agent/breeding manager.
4. All buyers must register with Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association in the Office and obtain a number prior to bidding. A current drivers license and address with phone number is required for payment by check.
5. Purchased breedings are NON REFUNDABLE and cannot be transferred without the approval of Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association. Exceptions to this rule are listed in the Stallion Service Agreement Contract. Contracts are available for review on our website, www.nethorsemen.com and at the auction.
6. Any breedings paid for the day of the auction will be made available to be re-sold. All breedings not sold or paid for on the day of the auction will be available until May 15, 2009 and posted on the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association website, www.nethorsemen.com. Breedings will be available for purchase at 60% of the posted stud fee plus \$50.00 office fee.
7. **Stallion Owners:** If your stallion's breeding is sold, you will be eligible to enter one horse by your stallion foaled in 2010 in one class in the Breeders Futurity to be held in 2010, 2011, OR 2012. Entry fee in ONE Breeders Futurity class is waived. If the mare that the sold breeding is used on dies during the breeding season and a refund is made to the mare owner, and the service cannot be resold, eligibility of the stallion's get and free entry is not affected. All get of your stallion in 2010 will be eligible for the Breeders Futurity with paid entries when the breeding is sold through the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association Stallion Service Auction. All get of your stallion in the year of 2010 are LIFETIME eligible for entry into Breeders Classes. Stallion owner will also be eligible to receive 10% of any Breeders Class winnings on ALL foals sired by their stallion during the 2009 breeding season.
8. **Mare Owners:** Foals resulting from the purchase of a breeding through the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association Stallion Service Auction are eligible for the Breeders Futurity with paid entry. Foal shall also be eligible for all Breeders Classes to be held in future years with paid entry.
9. Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association is selling a donated breeding for one breeding season only. Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association assumes no responsibility or liability for the conduct and/or performance of the stallion, stallion owner, stallion agent, mare, and/or mare owner. The purchase of the stallion service is for breeding purposes only and the mare owner will be responsible for all board, vet, transportation and any other fees associated with the breeding. Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association reserves the right to change its rules at any time. Any provisions not covered will be resolved by Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association. It is the responsibility of the participant to obtain and to be aware of the rules governing this stallion service auction and of the stallion owner/agent's contract. If a futurity is canceled due to circumstances beyond the club's control, (i.e. weather) and rescheduling is not feasible, money will be allocated to the subsequent year's futurity by the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association Board of Directors and the stallions will remain on the eligibility list the subsequent year.
