

## Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association

### Saddle Award Show Series

The Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association is proud to host our first Saddle Award Show Series. Saddles will be awarded to the high point exhibitor in the following divisions:

#### **Novice Youth, Youth, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Open**

Exhibitors competing for the saddle award **must show in all three** (3) shows to be eligible for the award. Show dates:

**March 27, 2010**

**July 24, 2010**

**October 23, 2010**

All shows will be held at the Hopkins County Civic Center in Sulphur Springs, TX.

Points will be awarded to up to 8 exhibitors in all classes. NETHA open show classes **ONLY** will be counted for the award. Points will be calculated as follows:

Points are awarded for one exhibitor/horse combination. **Exhibitor and Owner of horse must be a member of the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association to be eligible.** Membership must commence no later than March 27, 2010.

Eligibility:

Novice Youth and Novice Amateur Divisions: You must present a breed association card indicating your Novice status. If exhibitor does not have a breed association card, they must state their

eligibility for NOVICE status with the show office on a form made available on the day of the show. If exhibitor does not meet the NOVICE requirements, they will be required to show in Youth or Amateur classes, whichever applies.

Amateur Division: A breed association card must be presented indicating your amateur status. If no breed association card is available, the exhibitor must state their eligibility for AMATEUR status with the show office on a form made available on the day of the show. If the exhibitor does not meet the AMATEUR requirements, they will be required to show in the Open division.

Open Division: All eligible.

It is not a requirement that the exhibitor in any youth or amateur divisions own the horse they are showing. No minimum number of classes are required for any show. Halter is not required to compete for saddle award. Horse/Rider combination may compete in more than one division provided they meet eligibility requirements. Point Standings will be posted to the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association website, following each show. [www.nethorsemen.com](http://www.nethorsemen.com) Saddles will be awarded at the end of the show series, and no later than November 30, 2010.

All judges decisions are FINAL. Any discrepancies will be resolved by the Northeast Texas Horsemen's Association's Board Of Directors and that decision will be final. All shows are conducted based on the rules of the American Quarter Horse Association.
